Blue Jay Spinner (These spinners work best if printed on cardstock.)

 Color the blue jay with crayons or colored pencils.
 Cut out both big circles.
 Trace and cut out a third circle the same size from thin cardboard, such as an empty cereal box.
 Glue one piece onto the thin cardboard circle.
 Carefully poke holes through the two small circles inside the big circle.

6 Next poke holes through the small circles on the other piece.

7 Line up the holes. Make sure the circles both show the picture right side up.
8 Glue the second circle piece onto the cardboard.

9 Tie short strings through each small hole.

10 Hold a string end in each hand. Wind the spinner by swinging it around several times.

11 Gently pull each string to see the blue jay fly.

TIP: If the spinner is too light to wind easily, tie beads or buttons close to the small holes on each side.
