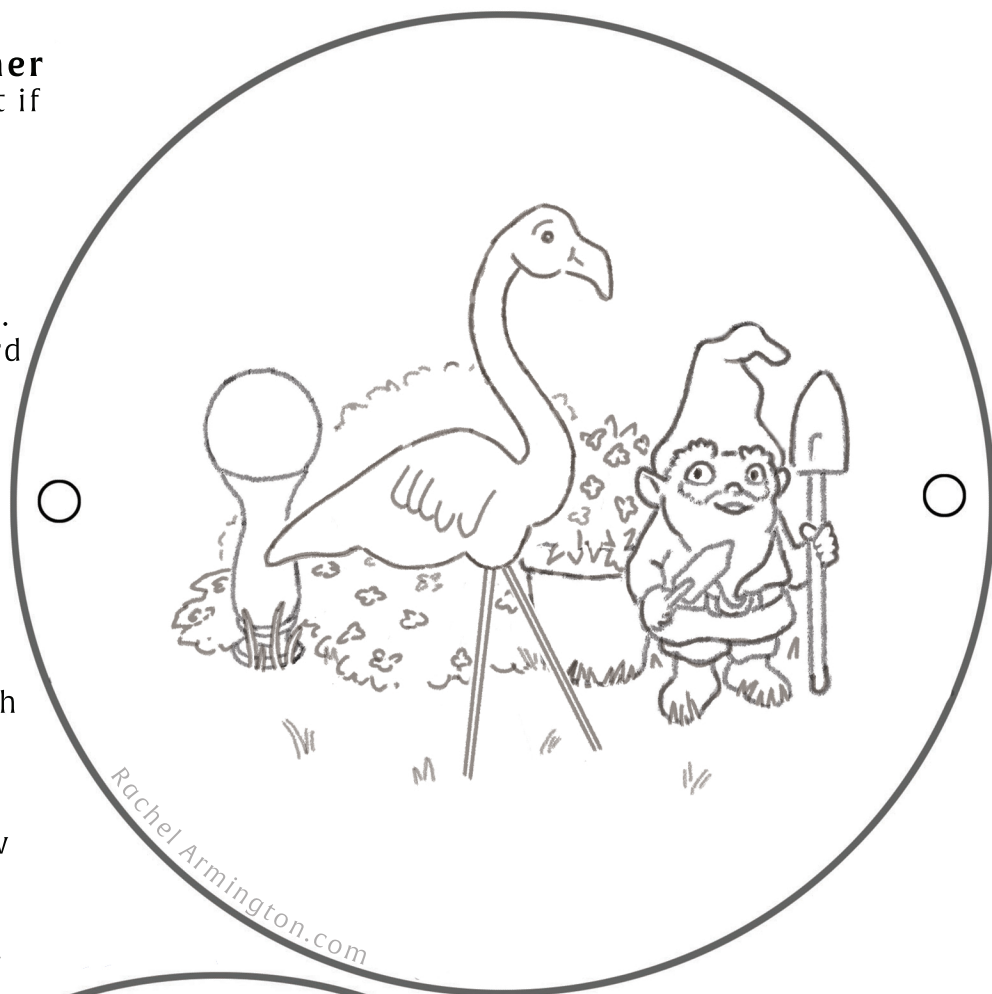


Plastic Flamingo Spinner

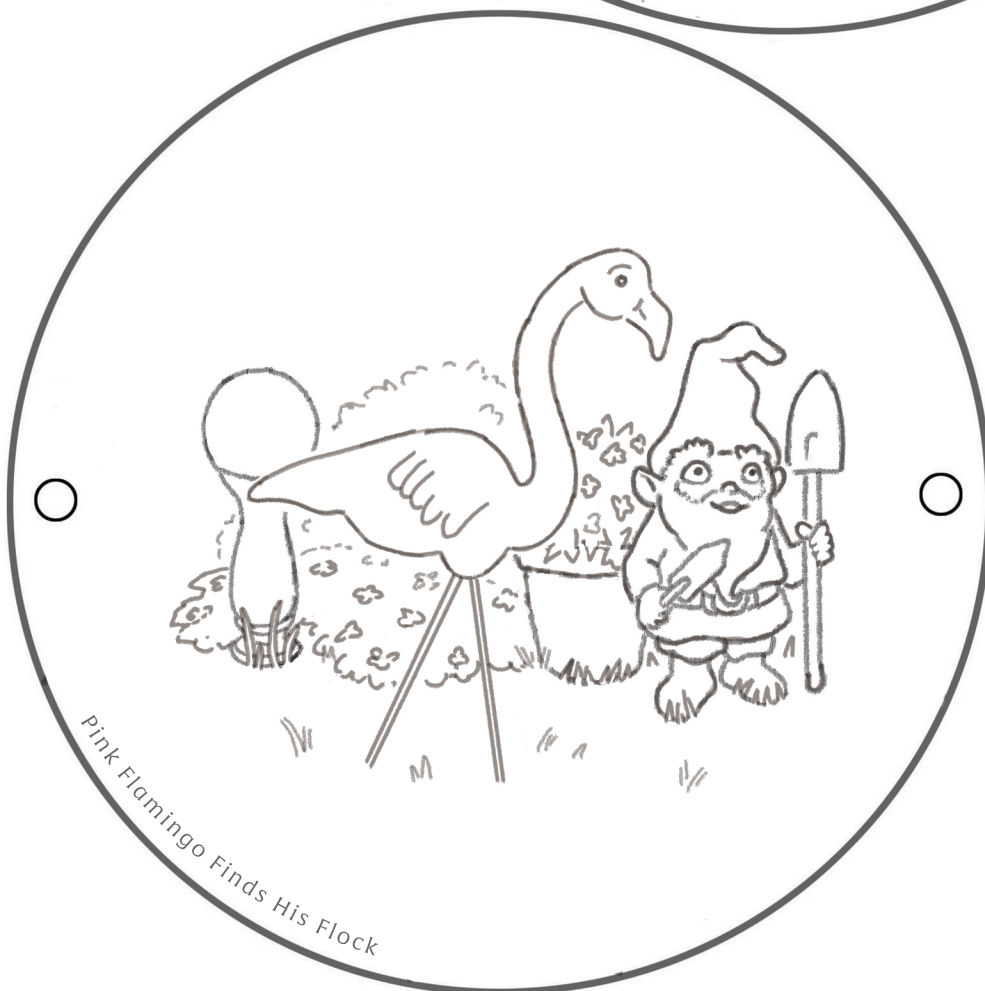
(These spinners work best if printed on cardstock.)

- 1 Color the flamingo and gnome with crayons or colored pencils.
- 2 Cut out both big circles.
- 3 Trace and cut out a third circle the same size from thin cardboard, such as an empty cereal box.
- 4 Glue one piece onto the thin cardboard circle.
- 5 Carefully poke holes through the two small circles on either side of the big circle.
- 6 Now poke holes through the small circles on the other piece.
- 7 Line up the holes. Make sure the circles both show the picture right side up.
- 8 Glue the second circle piece onto the cardboard.

9 Tie a short string through each small hole.

10 Hold a string end in each hand. Wind the spinner by swinging it around towards you several times.

11 Gently pull each string to see the plastic flamingo move.

TIP: If the spinner is too light to wind easily, tie beads or buttons close to the small holes on each side.
